- 1. Secretariat : Provision is for Secretariat Expenditure.
- 2. Office Buildings: Provision is for Major Works Construction of Office Buildings Atal Akshay Urja Bhawan.
- 4. Wind Power: Provision will be used for Wind Power (Generation Based Incentive) Projects and capacity of 4 GW is likely to be installed during 2018-19.
- 5. **Small Hydro Power:** It includes setting up of new small hydro power projects and renovation and modernization of small hydro projects.
- 6. **Bio Power:** It includes grid based bio gas and non-bio gas co-generation bio power projects.
- 7. **Solar Power:** It includes Scheme for Development of Solar PV Power Plant on Canal Bank/Canal Tops, Greening of islands, scheme for development Solar Parks and Ultra Mega Solar Power Projects, Defense Solar Scheme, Solar Rooftop Scheme, etc.
- 8. **Green Energy Corridors:** Union Government's component in Intra State Transmission Lines under the Green Energy Corridor Scheme for Renewable Energy Transmission infrastructure will be implemented.
- 12. **Externally Aided Project (EAP) Component:** It includes UNDP/GEF Projects on Scale up of Access to Clean Energy for Rural Productive Uses and IGEN Access under Indo German Bilateral Programme.

- 13. Interest Payment and Issuing Expenses on the Bonds: Provision for payment of Interest and issuing Expenses on the Bonds by the Indian Renewable Energy Development Agency (IREDA).
- 16. **Wind Power:** Provide for implementation of wind mills, wind based water pumps, wind based off-grid lighting, etc.
- Small Hydro Power: Provision for implementation of hydro based water pumps, water mills, micro hydel, hydro based off-grid lighting etc.
- 18. **Bio Power:** Provision for off-grid based bio gas and non-bio gas co-generation bio power projects. 30 MWeq projects will be undertaken under urban industrial and agriculture waste / residue programme.
- 19. Solar Power: Under the solar off-grid programme, it is proposed to install 72 lakh Solar Lighting Systems, 1.00 lakh Solar Pumps, Micro Grid and Power Pack projects. It includes Concentrated Solar Thermal scheme.
- 23. Other Renewable Energy Applications (Solar Cities, Green Buildings, Support to States, Demonstration of Renewable Energy Applications, Cookstoves, etc.): It is used for will be used for Unnat Chulha Abhiyan, Special Area Demonstration Project (SADP), improving the infrastructure of state nodal agencies and the budget allocated for solar cities/ green building, cook stoves programme will be used to meet the previous liabilities.
- 24. **Externally Aided Projects (EAP) Component:** It includes Provision for GEF-UNDP Project on Concentrated Solar Heater.

- 29. **Research and Development:** R& D activities on different aspects of New and Renewable Energy Technologies, Standards & Testing, Renewable Energy Assessment including Energy Storage have been kept under Research and Development.
- 41. **Monitoring/Evaluation and Other Studies:** Provision for Monitoring/Evaluation and Other Studies.
- 42. **Information Technology/e-Governance and other Initiatives:** Provision for Information Technology support and e-Governance and other related initiatives in the Ministry.
- 43. **Information, Education and Communications:** Provision for Central Financial Assistance (CFA) to provide Publicity & Awareness Support for Renewable Energy (RE) Programmes.
- 44. International Relations International Co-operation including Investment Promotion and Assistance to International Solar Alliance: Under International Co-operation, funds are allocated for International Solar Alliance and also for undertaking the training and capacity building programmes and other renewable energy projects in Member Countries.
- 45. **Human Resources Development and Training:** Human Resources Development and Training Programme will be used for funding the ongoing fellowship programmes, funds are also allocated for Surya Mitra Scheme launched by the Government during 2015-16.
