- 1. The provision is for expenditure on secretariat of the Department of Agriculture and Cooperation, Counsellor (Agriculture) Embassy of India, Rome and on Headquarters of Technology Mission on Oilseed and Pulses and also for Agriculture Marketing Directorate.
- 2. Provision was made for improving the working efficiency of National Seeds Corporation (NSC), State Farms Corporation of India (SFCI) and State Seeds Corporations (SSCs).
- 3. The provision includes expenditure on seed processing and infrastructural facilities, setting up of national seeds training centres, grants to States for strengthening of State Seed Certification Organisations, etc.
- 4. The provision is for minikit programmes of Cereals (rice, wheat and coarse cereal) meant for quick popularisation of the latest varieties of seeds and propagation of new production technology amongst the farming community all over the country.
- 5. The programme of Integrated Cereals Development sought to bring about substantial increase in production and productivity of rice, wheat and coarse cereals in the indentified States through use of certified seeds, improved farm implements including power fillers/sprinklers and transfer of technology through field demonstration on farmers fields and farmers training.
- 6. The main objective of the scheme is to increase productivity of maize on mission approach basis through the implementation of various types of demonstrations, training programmes.
- 7. A token provision has been kept for the new scheme of wheat and pulses production in Central India. The scheme is proposed to be launched in the Bundelkhand region of UP, central plateau and Bundelkhand region of MP, and plains, hills and plateau regions of Rajasthan for producing Durum types of wheat having export potential.
- 8. A new scheme for Technology Mission on Jute has been introduced during the current year. Jute being a Commercial Crop need development, research, production, marketing and utilization on the lines of Technology Mission on Cotton.
- 9. The provision is for Directorates of rice and millet development programmes.
- 10. The programme aims at raising the production of pulses by increasing the area under these crops. Short-duration package of practices in pulses cultivation, production of breeder seed and front line demonstration, by ICAR, etc. are the mechanism for the purpose.
- 11. The provision is for expenditure on development and use of Bio-Fertilizers and strengthening of Central Fertilizer Quality Control and Training Institute.
  - 12. The provision is for expenditure relating to plant

protection measures, such as Integrated Pest Management, plant quarantine facilities strengthening of lowest warning organisations, and implementations of insectisides Act etc.

- 13. The programme covers all the major oilseed crops namely groundnut, rapeseed, mustard, soyabean, sesamum, sunflower, safflower, niger, castor and lineseed. The pattern of financial assistance is 75: 25 between the centre and the state governments for all the key inputs. In addition, grants-in aid (100%) is given to ICAR for organising front line demonstrations. The main emphasis is on increasing the productivity through adoption of improved package of practices, input support services and transfer of technology, etc.
- 14. National Oilseeds and Vegetable Oil Development Board set up under the NOVOD Board Act, 1983 for integrated development of oilseed and vegetable oil industries. All aspects of oilseed industry and vegetable oil industry like production, processing, marketing, technological improvements and research, procurement, storage and maintenance of buffer stocks, etc. comes under its purview.
- 15. The provision is for research and development of postharvest technology in oilseeds and pulses concentrating mainly on (a) development and popularisation of modern oil expeller, (b) developing a proto-type for processing palm fruits, and (c) pre-servation and storage of pulses at the farm level etc.
- 16. The provision is for continuation of the existing Intensive Cotton Development Programme. Grants-in-aid is given to ICAR for organising frontline demonstration for, training to farmers for production of hybrid seeds to NSC/SFCI, for production and distribution of seeds.
- 17. The programme includes supply of seeds and seedlings (both from imports and indigenous sources), assistance to farmers for raising the crop and assistance for establishment of oil extraction units. etc.
- 18. The new scheme on efficient on farm water management for increasing crop production in Eastern India.
- 19. The project endeavours to achieve the twin objective of sustainable production of bio-mass and restoration of ecological balance in the vast tracts of rainfed areas in the country. It focuses on (i) Conservation, upgradation/utilisation of natural endowments like land water, plant, animal and human resources; (ii) Generation of employment; (iii) Improvement of production environment through scientific management of land and water; and (iv) Reduction of inequalities between irrigated and rainfed areas. The programme is addressed to all the blocks of the country with less than 30% of their cultivated area being served with assured means of irrigation.
- 20. The provision is for Watershed Development Council which was constituted with overall responsibility of execution of the World Bank assisted projects. The spill over works is still continuing.

- 21. The provision is for making expenditure on various Directorates responsible for development programmes of Commercial Crops.
- 22. Horticulture Development programme covers a wide range of crops, such as fruits, vegetables, floriculture, spices, cashewnut, coconut, mushroom, etc. This programme aims to increase the production and productivity by making available adequate quality planting material and input kits, organising demonstrations developing infrastructure for Post harvest technology/marketing. Provision has also being made for capital investment subsidy for Cold Storage. There are two directorates (Cashew and Spices) and two autonomous boards (National Horticulture Board and Coconut Development Board) looking after these crops. Special attention is also being given for the development of horticultural crops in the North Eastern States.
- 23. Under the scheme, technical guidance and financial assistance are provided for planning, implementation, and evaluation of extension and training facilities. It also includes providing effective dissemination of knowledge and techniques of advanced farm technology to the farmers through press, radio, television, instructional films, exhibitions, etc.
- 24. The Crop Insurance Scheme is implemented by Central Government through General Insurance Corporation of India Ltd. in collaboration with the State Government. Premium as well as claims are shared with them in the ratio of 2:1. All the farmers availing of crop loans from financial institutions for raising rice, wheat, millets, oilseeds and pulses are covered under the Scheme.
- 25. National Agricultural Insurance Scheme has been implemented w.e.f. Kharif, 1999 for enlarging Crop Insurance coverage of loanee and non-loanee farmers and for insurance coverage of additional crops.
- 26. The provision is for expenditure on agricultural census being carried out in the current Plan period. The main objective of the scheme is to obtain data on the structure of operational holdings and other matters needed for policy purposes.
- 27. The provision is mainly for schemes relating to collection, compilation and maintenance of agro-economic data/ economic analysis/compilation and dissemination of agro-economic intelligence for planning and policy decisions.
- 28. This relates to farm machinery training and testing institutes. They provides training to the progressive farmers, technicians, nominees of State Governments & Agro Industries Corporations, farming institutions and engineering entrepreneurs. These institutes also undertake testing and performance evaluation of farm machines. A token provision has also been kept on a new scheme 'Establishment of National Institute of Agricultural Mechanisation and Appropriate Technology in Bihar'.
- 29. The price support or market intervention measures are designed to ensure remunerative prices to farmers. NAFED is the Central designated agency for carrying out such operations. For price support schemes (pulses, oilseeds etc), the losses in the operations are to be fully reimbursed by the Govt. of India to NAFED. For the market intervention schemes (Horticultural crops), the losses are shared between centre and the states.
- 30. The provision is for providing loan assistance to State Farm Corporation of India for improving its efficiency as well as financial position.
- 31. The provision includes contribution to Food Agriculture Organisation and World Food Programme. The provision also includes the expenditures on Special Jute Development Programme, Sugarcane Development Programme, Natural Disasters, Management Programme and Small Farmers Agri-Business Consortium (SFAC) and a new scheme Establishment of a Network of Agricultural clinic/Business centres.

- 32. The provision is for expenditure relating to administration and implementation of the Insecticides Act.
- 33. This includes provision for agriculture marketing, such as quality control, market survey, and investigation. It also includes the provision for the Directorate of Marketing and Inspection, and for assistance to National Institutes of Agriculture Marketing.
- 34. The scheme is provision for reducing the rate of sedimentation and thereby to prolonging the usefulness of the reservoirs through vegetative measures, bunding, afforestation, pastures development, construction of silt detention bunds, check dams, water harvesting structure etc. The scheme is executed in the catchment areas of 41 river valley projects through States/ UTs who are provided Central Assistance in the form of 50% grants and 50% loans.
- 35. The provision is mainly for all India soil and land use survey and for grants to DVC for conducting training programme application of remote sensing technology for soil survey and reclamation and development of problem areas/soils.
- 36. This provision for Central assistance for State Plan schemes relating to shifting cultivation.
- 37. The basic objective of the scheme is to organise education of members of cooperatives and training of personnel of the State cooperative departments/cooperative institutions with the objective of making the members aware about the benefit of co-operatives. It also provides for human resources developments in the co-operative sector.
- 38. The National Cooperative Development Corporation promotes cooperative programmes on marketing, processing, storage, export and import of agricultural produce, food stuff, poultry feed. Provision is also used for strengthening the share capital base of cooperative sugar factories and cooperative spinning mills.
- 39. Land Development Banks constitute the principal agencies for providing long-term agricultural credit to the farmers for develop-mental purposes, like minor irrigation, land development, farm mechanisation, etc. The investment in debentures of LDBs is made to supplement the resources of these banks whose main source of finance is through floatation of debentures in the market.
- 40. Assistance is provided to State Governments by way of grants (75 per cent) and loans (25 per cent) to enable them to strengthen the Agricultural Credit Stabilisation Fund maintained at the level of Apex Cooperative Banks in each State. The objective is to use the funds to convert short-term production loans into medium term loans when the farmers cannot repay on account of natural calamities like floods, drought, etc.
- 41. The scheme is meant for removing regional disparities by assisting selected central cooperative banks in the under developed States with a term loan on a matching basis, in order to enable them to overcome the difficulties in meeting the non-overdue cover conditions of the NABARD.
- 42. A token provision only has been kept. The scheme aims at revamping of the cooperative (both long term and short term) credit structure particularly at grass root level i.e., Primary Agricultural Societies (PASs) by providing financial assistance.
- 43. The provision includes grants and loans to States for Woman/Weaker Sections. It also includes assistance to National Cooperative Federation.
- 44. So far, assistance to the States were given for implementing programmes as per scale/contents determined by the Government of India. To provide freedom and flexibility to the State Governments, for implementation of various centrally sponsored schemes on MOU basis, the new scheme "Supplementation/complementation of State's Efforts though Work Plans" has been formulated by integrating 27 ongoing schemes. It started operations from 2000-01.

- 45. Watershed Development Fund (WDF) has been established with NABARD to cover 100 priority districts within three years. The Central government provided matching assistance to NABARD who have mobilized Rs. 100 Crores in this regard.
- 46. The provision is for schemes/projects for the benefit of North Eastern States including Sikkim. The schemewise details of 197.00 crore are as under:-
