1. **Secretariat - Economic Services** : Provides for establishment related expenditure on Secretariat employees of Department of Disinvestment.

2. **Disinvestment Commission** : This Commission was set up in August 1996 initially for a period of 3 years. The Commission

is an advisory body to advise the Government of disinvestment in those public sector units that are referred to it by the Government and also carry out such other activities relating to disinvestment as may be assigned to it by the Government.
