1. **Secretariat**: This provides for the expenditure on the Secretariat of Ministry of External Affairs and expenditure on External Publicity.

## 2. External Affairs:

- 2.01 **Embassies & Missions**: This provides for expenditure on India's representation of 156 Missions/Posts abroad.
- 2.02 **Passport and Emigration :** The increase in RE 2000-2001 and BE 2001-2002 is mainly to cater to expenditure on the computerisation programme of the Passpost Offices, increased cost of passpot booklets, increased expenditure on account of newly opened Passport Offices/Collection Centres, enhanced rentals etc.
- 2.03 **Training**: The provision made under this head is for organising training programmes for Indian and Foreign Diplomats by Foreign Service Institute.
- 2.04 **Special Diplomatic Expenditure**: This provides for discretionary expenditure.
- 2.08 International Cooperation: This provides for the expenditure on mandatory payments of contributions to the United Nations and its agencies, Commonwealth Secretariat, Commonwealth Foundation, SAARC Secretariat. The enhancement is due to increase in contribution in Rupee terms on account of possible depreciation of the Indian Rupee vis-a-vis major foreign currencies.
- 2.09 **Other Expenditure**: This includes provision for demarcation of boundaries with neighbouring countries, Vice President's visits abroad, Haj Goodwill delegations, External

- Affairs hostels, grants-in-aid to various institutions, Republic Day and Independence Day celebrations abroad, etc. This includes a provision of Rs.39.65 crores in the current year and Rs.40.00 crores in the next financial year of ICCR. Provision has also been made for setting up a Chair on Indian History & Culture in the University of Oxford, United Kingdom, setting up of Indian Section in the Victoria & Albert Museum, London, expenditure on Indo-UK Round Table and Indo-EU Round Table and additional grant to Indian Council for World Affairs. Provision has also been made for expenditure on training in International Peacekeeping.
- 3. **Loss by Exchange**: The provision under this head caters for the net loss incurred by our Missions/Posts abroad on account of conversion of one currency to another etc. Only token provision has been made since accurate estimation of requirement is not possible.
- 6. **Technical and Economic Cooperation with Other Countries**: This provision is made for extending technical and economic assistance under various bilateral agreements and other special programmes to neighbouring and other developing countries. The provision also provides for Aid for Disaster Relief.

Advances to Foreign Governments: The provision is for extending line of credit/loans to the Governments of Bangladesh and Bhutan repectively, for developmental works in those countries.

7. **Public Works & Housing**: The provision is primarily for acquisition/construction and upkeep of residences and chanceries abroad.
