1. The provision is for expenditure on secretariat of the Ministry of Tribal Affairs.

2. Grants are sanctioned by the Minister for Tribal Affairs to deserving organisations and institutions working in the field of Tribal welfare and also to needy individuals.

3. Under this scheme, the grant are provided to the States on 50 : 50 basis and 100% in case of UTs for construction and expansion of hostels for Scheduled Tribes girls. This has proved to be an effective instrument in promoting literacy among Scheduled Tribes girls.

4. The objective of the scheme is to provide financial assistance to Scheduled Tribe students to pursue recognised post-matriculation courses in recognised institutions within India. The scheme provides for 100% Central Assistance to the State Govts. and Union Territory Administrations implementing the scheme, over and above their respective committed liability, which is required to be borne by them through their own resources. The committed liability of in respect of North-Eastern States has been dispensed with from the commencement of the 9th Five Year Plan period.

5. Under this scheme, grants-in-aid is given to the State Governments, on matching basis i.e.; on 50: 50 basis (100% in case of UTs) to promote educational facilities in tribal areas, like establishment of residential schools for STs in environment conducive to learning.

6. The provision is meant for share capital investment in Tribal Cooperative Marketing Development Federation of India (TRIFED), whose main objective is to help tribals to market their produce at remunerative prices and wean them away from exploitative private Traders and middlemen.

7. Under the scheme, grants are provided to the States on 50 : 50 basis and 100% in case of UTs for construction and expansion of hostels for ST boys. This has proved to be an

effective instrument in promoting literacy among the ST boys.

8. The provision relates to assistance to voluntary organisations for Scheduled Tribes, supporting projects of all-India or inter-State nature for Scheduled Tribes, Research and Training, price support to TRIFED, Grants-in-aid to State Tribal Development Cooperative Corporations for minor forest produce, Educational complex in low literacy pockets for the development of ST girls literacy in tribal areas, vocational training in tribal areas, Grant to Assam Govt. under clause (A) of second proviso to Article 275 (i) of the Constitution, Grain Banks in Tribal Areas, Book Banks, Coaching and allied scheme, upgradation of merit ST Students, National Commission for STs areas and Development of primitive tribal groups.

9. The concept of Tribal Sub-Plan has been designed for 194 integrated Tribal Development projects, 259 pockets of Modified Area Development approach, 82 clusters and 75 primitive tribal groups. The tribal sub-plan strategy aims at improving the Socio-economic conditions of the STs and protecting them from exploitation. The sub-plan approach covers 18 States and 2 Union Territories. Special Central assistance is given to the States as an additive to the State Plans.

10. Under this scheme the grant is given to the State Govts. to meet the costs of those special schemes as may be undertaken by them for promoting the welfare of Scheduled Tribes and to raise the level of administration in the Scheduled Areas.

11. **State Tribal Development Finance Corporations:** The provision is for participating in the share Capital Investment of State setting up of State Tribal Development Corporations in various States, who mobilises finances for economic development of Scheduled Tribes below povertyline.

12. **Lump-sum provision for benefit of North-Eastern Regions :** The provision is for implementing the scheme, for North Eastern Region and Sikkim.
