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- Secretariat Economic Services: Provision is for secretariat expenditure of the Department.
- 2. **Trade Commissioners:** Posted at 66 Trade Missions abroad, attend to trade inquiries and also assist in setting trade disputes and in organising exhibitions/fairs etc.
- 3. **Director General Foreign Trade:** It includes provision for administrative expenditure of organisation of the Director General of Foreign Trade and 31 Regional Import and Export Control Offices under him.
- 4. Assistance for Export Promotion and Market Development: The provision is for deemed exports benefit (duty drawbacks and refund of terminable Excise Duty). In addition, provision has also been made for payment of grants to Export Promotion Councils and other institutions for expenditure on specific export promotion schemes.
- 5. **Critical Infrastructure Balance:** The provision is for scheme for removing crucial bottlenecks in infrastructure, which hampers exports.
- 6. Development of Free Trade/Export Processing Zones/
 Special Economic Zones: It includes provision for Special
 Economic Zone at Gandhidham (Kutch), Santacruz Special
 Economic Zone Mumbai and Cochin Special Economic Zone –
 Cochin and Export Processing Zones at Chennai, Falta, Noida and
 Vishakhapatnam. Budget includes provision on plan side for
 construction and development and on non-plan side for
 administrative expenditure. Provision has also been made for setting
 up of Export Promotion Industrial Park in various States, Investment
 in ECGC and Assistance to IIFT for Administrative expenses.
- 7. Agricultural and Processed Food Products Export Development Authority (APEDA): Includes provision for payments against collection of cess to APEDA for development

and promotion of exports of certain agricultural and processed food products and matter connected therewith.

- 8. Marine Products Export Development Authority (MPEDA): It was set up with the object of developing and regulating the marine products industry with special reference to exports. Funds are released to MPEDA against the collection of Cess.
- 9. Other Schemes of Foreign Trade and Export Promotion: It provides for expenditure for Director General of Commercial Intelligence and Statistics, Exports Inspection Council, International Cooperation, Payment to IIP, Footwear Design and Development Institute, EAN-India for Bar Coding etc. Scheme for Central Assistance to the States for Developing Export Infrastructure and Allied Activities has been taken up in order to involve the states in export effort and Market Access Initiatives.
- 10. **Commodity Boards:** These have been set up for developing and increasing exports of certain important crops namely, rubber, tea, coffee, spices. Cess is levied on these commodities and from out of the cess proceeds, funds are released for the administrative and developmental expenditure of the Board for the Consolidated Fund of India.
- 11. Other Schemes of Plantations: These include provision mainly for payment to Tea Trading Corporation for running of Public Tea Warehouses.
- 12. **Tobacco Board**: This includes provision for revenue expenditure of the board.
- 13. Lump-sum provision for North-Eastern Region & Sikkim: Provision has been made for respective schemes, such as Tea, Coffee, Rubber and Spices and Infrastructure Scheme.
- 14. **Directorate General, Supplies and Disposals:** Under the decentralized arrangement for purchases, the Directorate is now mainly concerned with concluding rate contracts.
