1. **Secretariat - Economic Services** : Provides for establishment related expenditure of Secretariat employees of Ministry of Disinvestment.

2. **Disinvestment Commission** : This Commission was set up in August 1996 initially for a period of 3 years. The Commission

is an advisory body to advise the Government on disinvestment in those public sector units that are referred to it by the Government and also carry out such other activities relating to disinvestment as may be assigned to it by the Government. The provision in the Budget is for meeting the expenditure of the Commission including payment of consultancy fee, etc.
