1. Secretariat-Economic Services: Provides for the secretariat expenditure of the Minister of Planning and Minister of State for Planning.

2. **Planning Commission/Planning Board**: Provides for the expenditure of the Planning Commission including Programme Evaluation Organisation (PEO).

3. Provides for UNDP Assistance for preparation of State Human Resource Development Reports.

4. **WHO Assistance Scheme**: The objective of this scheme is to undertake country level assessment of water supply and sanitation. Planning Commission has signed an Agreement with WHO to undertake country level assessment of water supply and sanitation. The total value of this assistance is Rs.0.60 crore. The project is to conclude by June, 2002.

Others: (a) Grants-in-aid to the Institute of Applied 5. Manpower Research (IAMR), an autonomous body set up by the Government of India for advancement of knowledge about the nature, characteristic and utilisation of human resources in India and to provide manpower research services to Government Departments. (b) Grants-in-aid to Universities and Research Institutions for Training, Research and Institutions' Development etc., (c) Payment under the scheme "Payment for Professional and Special Services", (d) Modernisation of Office Systems, (e) 50th Year Initiative for Planning to build up a comprehensive data bank covering all important sectors reflecting nation's development and to prepare State Development Reports etc., (f) To provide grant assistance for Commission on Population which has been introduced as a result of setting up of National Commission on Population which is headed by the Prime Minister.
