NOTE: Against a Budget provision of Rs. 6500.00 crore in BE 2001-02, R.E. 2001-02 has been placed at Rs. 8500.00 crore for providing Additional Central Assistance to States for execution of Externally Aided Projects. The expenditure on such projects is initially incurred by States and thereafter reimbursement is claimed from Government of India. Therefore, the actual releases during the current year and next year to a particular State would depend upon the progress of the project in that State. The Budget provision for 2002-2003 is Rs. 6500.00 crore.
