This Demand includes provision for grants payable to States under Article 275(1) of the Constitution on the basis of the recommendations of the Eleventh Finance Commission; Block grants and loans for State Plan Schemes; Medium term Non-Plan loans; short term Ways and Means Advances to States and assistance from National Calamity Contingency Fund (NCCF) which has been set up following the recommendations of the Eleventh Finance Commission. NCCF will be funded out of accruals from the surcharge on personal and corporate income tax, levied for this purpose.

An initiative for sustainable human development, at the village level called '*Prime Minister's Gramodaya Yojana (PMGY)*' was introduced in 2000-2001. The scheme is to focus on Rural Roads, Rural Health, Drinking Water, Primary Education and Rural Housing. The estimates, in this regard, are included under Block grants and loans for State Plan Schemes. W.e.f. 2001-02, the Rural Roads component has been transferred to the Ministry of Rural Development under "Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojna"

as a 100% grant scheme. From the year 2002-03, National Social Assistance Programme (NSAP) (including Annapurna). Initiative for Strengthening Urban Infrastructure(ISUI) and Development and Reform Facility since remaned as Rashtriya Sam Vikas Yojana (RSVY) have been introduced as the schemes of Central assistance to State Plans. From the year 2003-04, Nutrition Programme for Adolescent Girls (NPAG) is the new scheme approved as Central Assistance to State Plans. Similarly, from the year 2003-04, a provision is being made for providing special grants-in-aid to States as compensation for their Revenue losses due to introduction of Value Added Tax (VAT) from April, 2003.

From the year 2002-03, the component-Assistance from Central pool of Resources for NE and Sikkim-has been transferred to the Department of Development of North Eastern Region (DONER).

The provisions included in this Grant represent transfer of resources by the Ministry of Finance and Company Affairs to the States and UTs.
