1. **Secretariat - Social Services:** Provides for the Secretariat service to the Department of Indian Systems of Medicine and Homoeopathy.

2. **Ayurveda:** Includes provision for (i) National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur which serves as a model institute for teaching, training, research and patient care, (ii) Central Council for Research in Ayurveda and Siddha and (iii) maintenance and development, grants-in-aid to Institute of P.G. Training and Research, Jamnagar, a constituent of Gujarat Ayurvedic University and Rashtriya Ayurveda Vidyapeeth, New Delhi. (iv) National Ayurvedic Hospital in Delhi and (v) Ayurveda Hospital, Lodhi Road, New Delhi.

3. **Homoeopathy:** Includes provision for Central Council for Research in Homoeopathy, grants to National Institute of Homoeopathy, Calcutta, which is an autonomous organisation, and grant for upgradation of Homoeopathic Post-Graduate Colleges, apart from provision for Homoeopathic Pharmacopoeial Laboratory, Ghaziabad, a subordinate office under the Department and Central Council of Homoeopathy, which is a statutory body.

4. **Unani:** Includes provision for (i) Central Council for Research in Unani Medicine (ii) National Institute of Unani Medicine, Bangalore (a model Institute for teaching, training, research and public health care) which are autonomous organisations fully financed by the Government.

5. **Yoga and Naturopathy:** Includes provision for grants to Central Council for Research in Yoga and Naturopathy, New Delhi, Morarji Desai National Institute of Yoga, New Delhi and National Institution of Naturopathy, Pune.

6. A lumpsum provision of Rs. 15 crore in BE 2003-2004 for projects/schemes for the benefit of N.E. Region and Sikkim.

7. **Others:** Includes Central Sector Schemes viz. Innovative Scheme for Medicinal Plants, National Board for Medicinal Plant, Extra Mural Research Project through Research Institute, Information, Education and Communication, International Exchange Programme, Patent Cell and statutory Institutions namely Central Council of India Medicine (CCIM), Central Council of Homoeopathy (CCH), India Homoeopathy Pharmacy Council, ISM Pharmacy Council etc. Besides it also includes PLIM, Ghaziabad, a subordinate office under the Department & Survey on Usage & Acceptability of ISM&H system.

It also includes Centrally Sponsored Schemes like upgradation of Deptt. of P.G. Training & Research in ISM, Upgradation of ISM&H UG colleges, Training of Physicians, Teachers technicians and Research Workers in ISM&H and State Drug Testing Laboratories/Pharmacies.

It also has provision for launching schemes viz. Speciality Clinics in Govt. Hospitals, TKDL, Pharmacy Councils, setting up of ISM Wing in District Hospitals, Ayurveda Park/Panchkama in Hotels, incentives to ISM&H Industries, Essential Drugs for Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani & Homoeopathy Dispensaries for rural and backward areas in various States, strengthening of enforcement mechanism for quality control etc.

8. **Investment in Public Enterprises:** Indian Medicines Pharmaceutical Corporation, Ranikhet is a joint venture with Kumaon Mandal Vikas Nigam (A UP Government Undertaking) for supply of medicines of Indian systems of medicine and homoeopathy to Government institutions, etc. and sale in open Market.
