1. **Secretariat-Economic Services**: Provides for the secretariat expenditure of the Minister of Planning and Minister of State for Planning.

2. **Planning Commission/Planning Board**: Provides for the expenditure of the Planning Commission including Programme Evaluation Organisation (PEO).

3. Provides for UNDP Assistance for preparation of State Human Resource Development Reports.

4. **National Bio-Diesel Mission:** This new Scheme has been approved with the objective of studying availability of various feed stocks of bio-fuels, blends of petrol/diesel with extract of nonedible oil seeds for the purpose of reducing the imports of petroleum and other derivatives and for creating employment opportunities in rural areas. 6. **Others**: (a) Grants-in-aid to the Institute of Applied Manpower Research (IAMR), an autonomous body set up by the Government of India for advancement of knowledge about the nature, characteristic and utilisation of human resources in India and to provide manpower research services to Government Departments, (b) Grants-in-aid to Universities and Research Institutions for Training, Research and Institutions' Development etc., (c) Payment under the scheme "Payment for Professional and Special Services", (d) A Plan Scheme "Grants-in-aid to IAMR" for making provision for infrastructural facilites at Narela Campus, (e) 50th Year Initiative for Planning to build up a comprehensive data bank covering all important sectors reflecting nation's development and to prepare State Development Reports etc.
