Army, Navy and Air Force and also employees of Ordnance Factories etc. It covers payment of service pension, gratuity, family pension, disability pension, commuted value of pension, leave encashment and casualty

awards such as War-Injury Pay and Gallantry awards like Param Vir Chakra, Mahavir Chakra etc.

The requirement of allocation in BE 2004-05, shows an additional requirement of Rs.250 crore over RE 2003-04, mainly on account of normal annual growth in number of pensioners during 2004-05.
