1. **Secretariat-Economic Services:** Provides for the Secretariat expenditure of the Ministry.

2. Planning Commission/Planning Board:

- (a) Provides for the expenditure of Planning Commission including Programme Evaluation Organisation (PEO).
- (b) The Plan scheme Modernisation of Office Systems is being operated for renovation and modernization of office premises and equipment etc.
- (c) (i) As envisaged in the 'National Population Policy 2000', National Commission on Population was established and its budget is being included in the budget of the Planning Commission.
- (c) (ii) Under a new scheme of Grants-in-aid to PRIs/NGOs, VOs, YOs and other Organisations for Population Stabilization, financial assistance is being provided to organizations/institutions for the projects relating to control & stabilization of Population through various measures.
- (d) "Information Technology" head has been opened to make a separate budget provision for meeting the expenditure on acquisition of hardware/software, development & maintenance of software, etc.

3. **UNDP Assistance:** Provides for UNDP Assistance for preparation of State Human Development Reports.

5 & 6. The lumpsum provision of Rs.6,000 crore is for new/ restructured schemes of the Central Ministries/Departments. Similarly, the provision of Rs.4,000 crore is for new/restructured schemes under State and UT Plans. These new/restructured schemes will subserve the objectives of the National Common Minimum Programme. Programmes/Schemes such as Food for Work Programme, Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan, Mid-day Meal Scheme, Basic Health Care, Railway Safety, Accelerated Irrigation Benefit Programme, Drinking Water, Public Investment in Agriculture and Roads, etc. will also be accommodated.

- 7. Others:
- (a) For providing Grants-in-aid to IAMR for carrying out research studies which are of interest to Planning Commission.
- (b) For providing 'Grants-in-aid to IAMR' for making provision of infrastructural facilities at Narela Campus.
- (c) Grants-in-aid to Universities and Research Institutions for training, research and institutional development, etc.
- (d) Payment under the Scheme "Payment for Professional and Special Services."
- (e) 50th Year Initiative for Planning to build up a comprehensive data bank covering all important sectors reflecting nation's development and to prepare State Development Reports, etc.
