1. Controller of Stationery is responsible for purchase and supply of stationery stores for all Central Government offices.

2. This provision is for Government printing presses including Text Book Presses which attend to bulk of Government printing work.

3. Controller of Publication is a central organisation to stock, distribute and sell Government publications.

4. Provision includes expenditure of the Directorate of Printing, Form Stores, printing through private presses and Text Book Presses.
