- 2. Provision is for maintenance and repairs of non-residential buildings and other major and minor works pertaining to various Government Departments.
- 3. & 4. The provisions are for construction of functional office buildings and other non-residential buildings by the Central Public Works Department on behalf of various Ministries/Departments.
- 5. This covers establishment related expenditure of the Land & Development Office and grants-in-aid to Rajghat Samadhi Committee, maintenance, caretaking and security of other identified Samadhis of National importance. L&DO is responsible for administration of Nazul Land leases and Rehabilitation leases transferred from the Department of Rehabilitation in Delhi.
- 6. The provision is for providing subsidy to NBCC to enable it to discharge its outstanding interest liabilities.
