Secretariat-Economic Services

 The provision is for meeting the expenditure on the Secretariat of Ministry of Tourism.

Direction & Administration

2. The provision is for meeting the expenditure on the headquarter establishment of the Directorate General of Tourism and the regional and field offices under it. Their main activities are dissemination of tourist information, development of tourism infrastructural facilities, regulation of various segments of travel industry such as hotels, travel agents, guides etc. It also includes provision for Information Technology.

Tourist Information & Publicity

3. This provision is meant for meeting the expenditure on production of publicity material for the promotional programs of the Department. The image of India is projected mainly through electronic and print media campaigns. Activities for which provisions have been made also include participation in Fairs and Festivals, India Evenings/Seminars, Special Interest Tours, Charter Flights etc. and for production of Brochures, Films Photographs etc.

Tourist Infrastructure

4. This provision relates to the expenditure on creation of Infrastructural facilities like Tourist Bungalows, Yatri Niwas, Forest Lodges, Wayside Amenities, Beach Resorts, Tourist Transport, Procurement of Trekking, Mountaineering, Winter/Water Sports

Equipment/Golf Courses/Refurbishment of monuments etc. in places of tourist interest.

Training

5. The provision is meant for Grants-in-aid to Indian Institute of Tourism and Travel Management, Institute of Hotel Management, Catering Technology and Applied Nutrition and Food Crafts Institutes for meeting the manpower requirements of various segments of Travel and Hotel Industry.

Other Expenditure

- 6. This provision includes payment of Interest Subsidy specified on the loans advanced by financial institutions for construction of Hotels upto 3 Star category. It also includes provision for Market Research, revival of Tourism in Jammu & Kashmir and contribution to International Bodies and making payment arising out of the Post Closing Adjustments in respect of disinvested hotels signed by the parties with the Government of India.
- 7. The provision is for the projects/schemes for the benefit of North Eastern Region and Sikkim.

Miscellaneous General Services

9. The provision includes payment of loss by exchange for Government of India Tourist Offices abroad.
