NOTE: Against the budget provision of Rs. 587.33 crore as grant component in BE 2005-06, RE 2005-06 has been placed at Rs. 7400.00 crore as loan/grant component for providing Additional Central Assistance to the States for execution of Externally Aided Projects. The expenditure on these projects (except structural adjustment programmes) is initially incurred by the States and thereafter reimbursement is claimed from Government of India. During the Financial Year 2005-06, the releases for ongoing state sector projects signed on or before March 31, 2005 are being made on existing arrangement in the Loan/grant ratio of 10:90 for special category states and 70:30 for Non Special Category States. However, the releases for new projects signed on or after April 1, 2005 are being made on back to back basis to the irrespective States as per accepted recommendations of the XII Finance Commission. The Budget Provision for 2006-07 is Rs. 4697.00 Cr.
