- 1. The provision is for expenditure on secretariat of the Ministry of Urban Development.
- 2. Town and Country Planning Organisation is a technical, advisory and consultative organisation which is concerned with urban and regional planning. It also guides the State Governments in organising their town and country planning activities and in formulating allied legislation.
- 3. The provision includes contribution to National Capital Region Planning Board which finances projects in National Capital Region with the objective of achieving a balanced and harmonised development of National Capital Region and reducing the pressure of population of NCT of Delhi.
- 4. The provision is for other Urban Development Schemes viz. National Urban Information system, Pooled Finance Development fund, Urban Transport Planning, Research and Capacity Building in Urban Sector, Mission Mode on IT, National Institute of Urban Affairs, Delhi Urban Art Commission and also provision for new schemes for National Urban Infrastructure Fund, Development of satellite cities/Counter Magnet cities, Capacity Building in Urban Transport Sector and North Eastern Region Urban Development Projects to be assisted through World Bank/ADB support.
- 5. Provision is for grants to Bharat Earth Movers Ltd. (BEML) for R&D Centre of Excellence
- 6. The provision is for infrastructure facilities for Commonwealth Games.

- 7. The provision is to meet the expenditure for preparation of City Development plans, detailed project reports and organizing technical seminars, symposiums and consultancy etc.
- 8. Directorate of Estates is responsible for the allotment of general pool office and residential accommodation, management of Government hostels and holiday homes in various cities apart from Vigyan Bhavan and Mavalankar Hall.
- 9. The provision is for construction and maintenance of Government residential buildings including Rashtrapati Bhavan, which also covers maintenance and repairs, Major and Minor Works, Furnishings, Rents, Lease charges, etc.
- 10. Provision is for solid waste management near airport in the few selected cities.
- 11. The provision is for loans to DMRC for payment of Central Taxes.
- 12, 13 & 14. The provision is for investment and grant to Delhi Metro Rail Corporation and investment in Bangalore Metro Rail Corporation.
- 15, 16 & 17. Provision is for investment in Chennai Metro Rail Project.
- 18 & 19. Provision is for investment in Kolkatta Metro Rail Corporation.
 - 20. Provision is for other Metro Rail Projects.
- 21. Lumpsum provision for projects/schemes for the benefit of the North Eastern Region and Sikkim.
