This is a composite Demand which provides for the requirements of all the Central Ministries and Departments and their subordinate organisations and Union Territory administrations (like Chandigarh, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, etc.) for payment of loans and advances to their employees. It also includes provisions for advances to Members of Parliament for purchase of motor conveyance.

The purpose for which the interest-bearing loans are advanced include house-building, purchase of conveyance, purchase of computers, etc.

The provision for House Building Advance is counted against accretions in the funds under Central Government Employees Group Insurance Scheme.
